

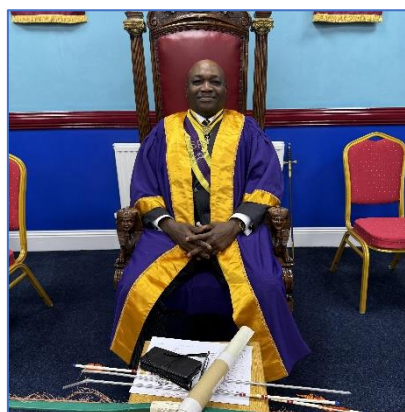


A Busy Afternoon for Hill of Zion
